The following drivers will use a new internal combustion engine (ICE) for the remainder of the Event:

The internal combustion engine used by Mick Schumacher is the fifth of the three new internal combustion engines allowed for the 2022 Championship season and this is **not** in conformity with Article 28.2 of the 2022 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The following drivers will use a new exhaust system (EX) for the remainder of the Event:
